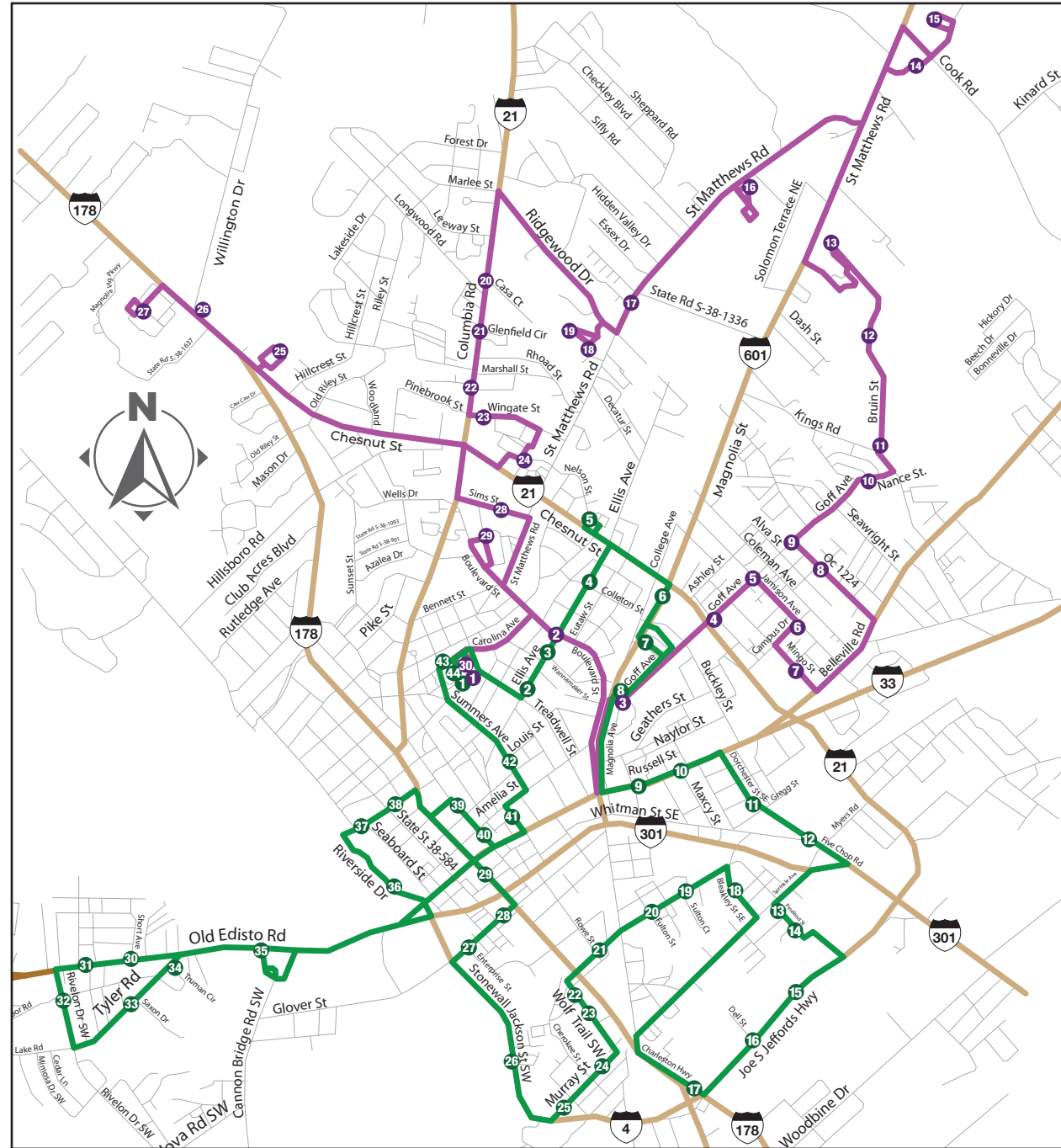
TIPS FOR RIDING

- Children under 14 must be accompanied by a fare paying adult; children under the age of 6 ride for free with a fare paying adult
- Elderly individuals 60 years or older, persons with disabilities and/or Medicare card holders ride for half-fare on the Downtown Circulator
- When riding the Downtown Circulator, it's best to be at your bus stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time
- Be kind, courteous and considerate of other passengers and your driver
- Cell phones are allowed, however, no speaker phone usage is permitted
- No eating, smoking, alcohol or controlled substances, weapons, profanity, or other disruptive behavior will be tolerated
- Service animals are permitted



All Cross County Connection buses are ADA accessible. Buses are also equipped with bicycle racks; bikes ride free!

DOWNTOWN CIRCULATOR

- Please wait at a designated bus stop along the route and watch for the bus to arrive.
- As you board the bus, please have the exact fare or ticket ready to place in the fare box. Drivers do not make or carry change.
- Please reserve the seats in the front of the bus for our disabled customers and senior citizens.
- When you are ready to depart the bus, pull the cord above the window and the driver will stop at the next bus stop.
